## Application Deadlines

**Summer:** Friday, May 17, 2024

**Early Academic:** Friday, May 17, 2024

**Academic Year/Fall:** Friday, July 12, 2024

**Winter/Spring Only:** Friday, Oct. 18, 2024

## Undergraduate students must:

- Have a college GPA of at least 2.5
- Have good citizenship record
- Be currently enrolled in an institution that is a member of the ACA Consortium (if you are not, please contact us)
- No prerequisite for ACA language programs except for the academic year Spanish programs

Visas are usually required for students with American passports who spend more than 90 days in the program of their choice. ACA is not responsible for denied or delayed visas that may affect travel arrangements.
