  - c. **This form must be printed, uploaded, or saved for submission to the ACA Campus Coordinator at the Adventist College.**
  
15. **Create an account with an Adventist University and contact the ACA Campus Coordinator. They may have additional requirements (transcripts, payment, etc.).**
