How to Apply – Step by Step

1. Search for the Global Internship opportunity that best fits your interest on the ACA website
2. Submit your application and upload your resumé and a Letter of Interest
3. Wait for acceptance and invitation from the host institution
4. Log in to the ACA website and collect the needed signatures from your home university on the PDF application form (allow approximately 2 weeks)
5. Your application is complete when your home university uploads the signed PDF application form to the ACA website
6. When you receive the ACA acceptance package email, you can purchase your plane ticket and prepare for your experience
7. After completing the internship and the ACA program evaluation, you will receive a Certificate of Completion for your home university to award credit

Applying to ACA

Application for Summer 2027 and Academic Year 2027-2028 opens October 1, 2026

APPLICATION DEADLINES

- May 21, 2027 Summer and Full Academic Year
- July 16, 2027 Fall Quarter / First Semester
- Nov. 12, 2027 Winter Quarter / Second Semester
- Feb. 11, 2028 Spring Quarter

Apply early! Some programs fill quickly. Begin your application as soon as possible to help secure a place in your preferred program.

Undergraduate Students

Applicants must enroll through an Adventist University/College, have a minimum GPA of 2.0.

1. Create an account at acastudyabroad.com/login/.
2. Complete the application and consult your ACA Campus Coordinator or ACA for guidance.
3. Obtain the signatures on your PDF application form from your sending institution.
4. Your application is complete when your institution uploads the PDF application form to the ACA website.

Not enrolled at a participating institution? You may apply as a guest student and transfer the credits to your home institution. Contact ACA for assistance.

After You Apply

Check your email. Accepted applicants will receive an email with the ACA acceptance package. If a visa is required, ACA will provide supporting documents and general guidance.

High School Students

High School Credit (10 semester hours / 1 Carnegie Unit)

Eligibility: All students 15 years of age and older who are enrolled in an Adventist academy in the North American Division of Seventh-day Adventists.

College Credit (6 semester credits / 9 quarter credits)

Eligibility: Students entering their junior or senior year by the start date of the program (meaning they have completed their sophomore year before the summer quarter begins).

Dual Credit (10 semester hours + 6 semester credits)

Eligibility: Students entering their junior and senior year of high school who are also enrolled in an Adventist academy.

Credits: You will receive both the high school and college credits listed in the "High School Credit" and "College Credit" sections if the educational entity approves them.

Non-Credit Applicants

Professionals, graduate students, and other adults may join an ACA summer or academic-year program through the non-credit pathway.

Create an account, complete the online application, sign the PDF application form, and make \$100 USD payment. The total cost is due one month before departure.

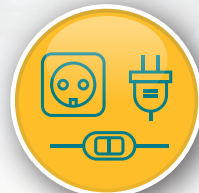

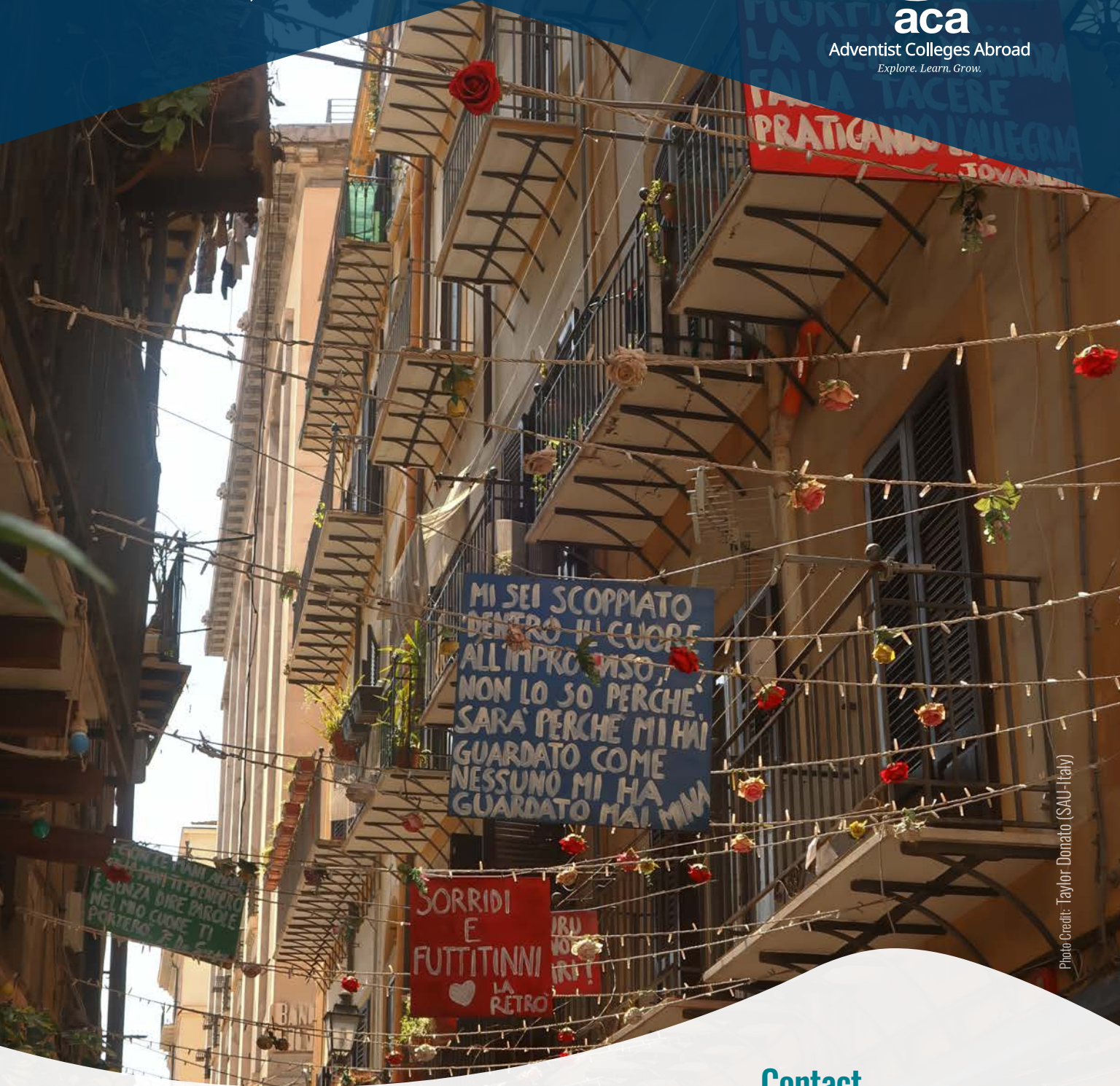
